

Here's a reminder of accepted plastics: Accepted plastics include: pallet wrap and stretch film, grocery bags, bread bags, case overwrap, dry cleaning bags, newspaper sleeves, ice bags, wood pellet bags, ziplock bags, produce bags,

bubble wrap and air pillows, salt bags, and cereal bags. (NOTE: All plastic must be clean, dry, and free of food residue.)

BROWNED BEEF STEW WITH DUMPLINGS

Main Ingredients:

2 lb. cubed beef

1/8 tsp. pepper

3 Tbsp. melted margarine

1 qt. boiling water

2 Tbsp. flour 11/2 tsp. salt

1 tsp. lemon juice

Cube meat and brown in melted margarine. Keep sizzling hot until nicely browned. Sprinkle meat with flour, salt and pepper. Add boiling water and lemon juice to improve flavor and tenderize meat. Cover pan and lower heat. Simmer fo 3 hours.

Dumplings:

1 c. flour

1 egg

1/2 tsp. salt

2-3 Tbsp. milk

11/2 tsp. baking powder

Stir all dumpling ingredients together quickly and drop from a spoon onto simmering stew. Cover completely and cool on very low heat for 12 to 15 minutes. Do not lift lid until dumplings are done. Serves 6 to 8.

CORN CHOWDER

3 slices bacon, cut into small pieces 2 cans creamed corn

1 medium onion, sliced

2 cups. diced potatoes

3/4 cups. water

1 1/2 cups. milk

2 Tbsp. butter

pepper to taste



Fry bacon to render out the fat. Add onion that has been sliced paper thin and cook through. Drain fat. Add diced potatoes and water. Bring to a boil and simmer for 10 to 15 minutes until the potatoes are tender. Add creamed corn, milk, butter and pepper to taste. Heat through and serve.
